



JHALANA PARK SAFARI

Are you a wildlife enthusiast? Then there is an opportunity knocking at your door step.

In the middle of the hustle bustle of Jaipur is the protected forest of Jhalana leopard reserve, a dry deciduous forest, spread over 21sq.km. This small patch of forest shelters a very healthy and sustainable population of Indian Leopards.

Jhalana has approximately 20-22 leopards. The chances of sighting these beautiful elusive cats here are very high. Along with leopard, it is home to The Blue bull (Asia's largest Antelope), Spotted deer, Grey mongoose, Black naped Hare, Porcupine, Fox and Hyenas etc . Jhalana is brilliant for bird watching as well, it hosts about 150 different species of birds. Indian Peafowl, Francolins, Shikra, Drongos , Babblers, Parakeets, Indian Pitta,

Rollers, Bee eaters can be seen here.

The safaris, are run on daily basis in an open 4 by 4 vehicles, it is also to encourage wildlife awareness and leopard conservation.

We start this trip from Samode Haveli, where you would be taken to the park in a chauffeur driven car. The drive to the park entrance is 12 kms which takes about 25 to 30 minutes.

Time duration allowed in the park: - 3 hours
